**ORDER**

The 05 (five) institutions mentioned in table below submitted applications to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition to B.Ed. or equivalent course in terms of Section 14(1) of NCTE Act, 1993, among others.

2. The NCTE at its 109<sup>th</sup> meeting (second sitting) and 110<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 and 11<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 at NCTE Hqrs. New Delhi, considered applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Reports, Video Recording, Original File etc. found the institutions mentioned in table below fit for grant of recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names subject to the condition of appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the norms of NCTE/State Govt./Affiliation University/Body given effect before the commencement of the course etc..

4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1+7 for the proposed B.Ed. Course.
- The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
- That the Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
- Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.

- (f) The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (g) The institutions shall regularly update their website.
- (h) The institutions intending to run the teacher training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to shift to their permanent building. They are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject.

5. The order of recognition for every institution shall follow separately.

6. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and / or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. The NCTE Hqs. may also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.

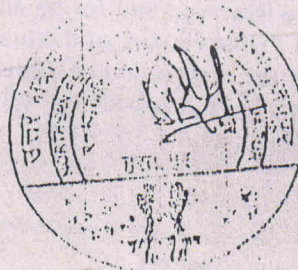

ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution i.e. Maa Kasturba Gandhi Mahila College of Education, 247, Krishna Nagar, Bharatpur, Rajasthan has been recognized for B.Ed. by NRC vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-78470 dt 14.11.2006 for an intake of 100.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution Maa Kasturba Gandhi Mahila College of Education, 247, Krishna Nagar, Bharatpur, Rajasthan has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in B.Ed. which require additional facilities.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely.

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The application-Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii) The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these condition by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- (iv) In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Northern Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

5. Now therefore, in the light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to Maa Kasturba Gandhi Mahila College of Education, 247, Krishna Nagar, Bharatpur, Rajasthan for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein, before 31.10.2015



6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.


7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure.

- (a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution.
- (b) Name of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- (c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- (d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- (e) Fee charged from students.
- (f) Available infrastructural facilities.
- (g) Facilities added during the last quarter.
- (h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- (i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- (j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- (k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
